

CLINTON FOUNDATION OVERVIEW



Help build a stronger Haiti

After the devastating earthquake in 2010, President Clinton formed the Clinton Foundation Haiti Fund and raised \$16.4 million from individual donors for immediate earthquake relief efforts. In 2011, the Clinton Foundation refocused its efforts in Haiti from emergency planning, putting emphasis on helping to build a stronger Haiti that relies less on foreign aid and more on the enterprise of its people.

Through Clinton Foundation Signature Projects, Stern students have the opportunity to support the restoration of Haiti's communities through projects related to private sector investment, job creation, capacity building and education. Students in this program are mentored by dedicated consultants from Strategy& (formerly Booz & Co) in order to maximize their learning and potential for impact.

World Wildlife Fund: UAE Initiative



Engage in a unique collaboration with the Global Network University (GNU)

Wadi Wurayah was recognized by the World Wildlife Fund as an important area for conservation as part of their Eco Region 200 analysis. In 2005, WWF (through Emirates Wildlife Society in the UAE) recommended for the Ruler of Fujairah to officially protect Wadi Wurayah. Wadi Wurayah National Park should ideally become an independent entity under the governance of Fujairah. It must add value to the emirate (not necessarily from a direct financial perspective).

Through the World Wildlife Fund project, Stern students have the opportunity to support the conservation of Wadi Wurayah park by creating a business plan to formally make it a National Park. Students in this program are mentored by dedicated consultants from McKinsey & Company in order to maximize their learning and potential for impact.


