Earn Your MBA In Two Years, While You Work

The Executive MBA program is structured to enable students to earn an MBA in General Management from NYU Stern while still keeping up with their professional and personal responsibilities.

Classes start in August and are held **one weekend a month - on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday** - at NYU's convenient downtown DC location. Students complete 60 credits on this schedule and also participate in three required week-long residencies and two class weekends in NYC.

Executive MBA students receive a high level of individualized attention. From meals to class materials, our **dedicated Student Services** team manages the logistical details so that students are free to focus on what matters most - work, life, and school.

The core curriculum, completed in Year One, provides a strong foundation in all the **key areas of business administration**. As part of the core curriculum, all students participate in a strategic capstone project and a required Global Study Tour.

In Year Two students can customize their learning with a diverse portfolio of elective courses and the option to **specialize in up to two areas of study**. Electives provide students with the opportunity to build on the foundation of the core curriculum and go deeper into advanced topics in subject areas or to simply explore different aspects of several different disciplines.

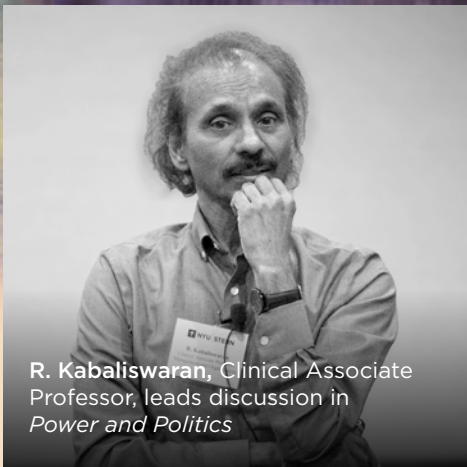
Executive MBA students in DC learn from the same faculty that teach in New York City.

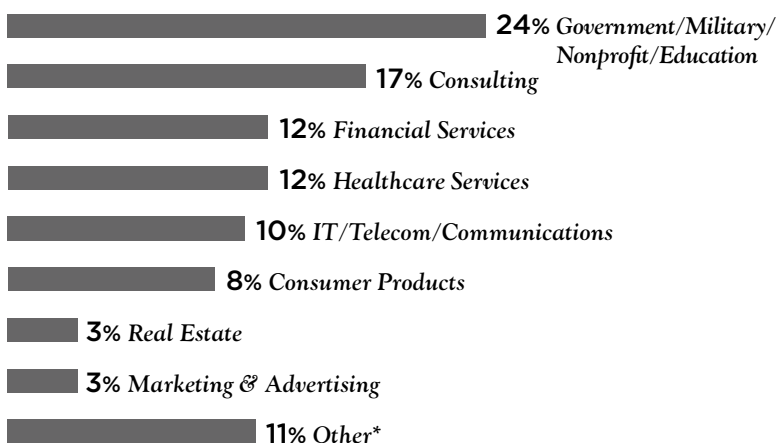
